- b. Options for money if not able to hire for interventionist/reading specialist: Possible software/technology purchases but must be approved and have a bid first

- 7. TAPR Report- Principal reviewed TAPR report with CAC team and shared the CIP goals, performance objectives and strategies that were built from the TAPR report
